NOTICE OF THE 2019 CIRCUIT

The Classics Mare Nostrum Trophy is organised by the Real Club Náutico de Barcelona (RCNB), the Club de Mar-Mallorca (CDM), the Club Marítimo de Mahón (CMM) and the Club Náutico Puerto Sherry (CNPS).

1. Regattas

The IX Mare Nostrum Trophy will be formed by the following regattas:

2. Rules

The trophy will follow the rules established in each Notice of Race of the regattas that form the trophy and in the correspondent Sailing Instructions.

3. Participating Classes

The regatta is open for the following Classes, as defined by the CIM:

- a) Gaff Rig Vintage
- b) Bermudan Vintage
- c) Classics
- d) Spirit of Tradition (SOT)
- e) Big boats (boats of the previous classes, larger than 23m LOA)

4. Entries

A boat is considered registered in the 2019 Classics Mare Nostrum Trophy if is registered in at least two of the regattas mentioned in point 1 and comply with point 5.2 of this document.

5. Scoring

5.1. For the delivery of the Trophy, the following score system will be applied:

- a) The points scored by each boat in the final classification of her class in each regatta that form the Trophy, will be divided by the number of participants in that Class in that regatta.
- b) For each boat, the points obtained in each regatta will be added.
- c) The winner in each Class will be that who scores fewer points.

5.2. A participant will be considered as such, according to the previous paragraph, if it starts at least one race in at least two regattas of the three that form the Trophy.

5.3. A participant boat (see 5.2.) that doesn't take part in a regatta will be considered, according to the score of the Trophy, as DNS in each one of the races of such regatta.

6. Classifications

A classification will be established for each one of the participating classes.

7. Trophies

7.1. The first classified in each participating Class will be those who receive the 2019 Classics Mare Nostrum Trophy.

7.2. The trophies will be delivered in the venue and date opportunely indicated.

8. Languaje

In case of discrepancy between the Spanish and the English version of this Notice, the English text will prevail.

9. Information

The Circuit's official website (www.trofeomarenostrum.com) will have information about it.
