NOTICE OF THE 2017 CIRCUIT

The VII Classics Mare Nostrum Trophy is organized by the Real Club Náutico de Barcelona (RCNB), the Club de Mar-Mallorca (CDM), the Club Marítimo de Mahón (CMM) and the Club Náutico Puerto Sherry (CNPS) with the collaboration of the Real Asociación Nacional de Cruceros (RANC) and the Asociación Española de Barcos de Epoca y Clásicos (AEBEC).

1. REGATTAS

1.1. The Mare Nostrum Trophy will be formed by the following regattas:

2. RULES

2. 1. The trophy will follow the rules established in each Notice of Race of the regattas that form the trophy and in the correspondent Regatta Instructions.

3. PARTICIPATING CLASSES

3. 1. The regatta is open for the following Classes, as defined by the CIM:

- a) Gaff Rig
- b) Marconi
- c) Classics
- d) Spirit of tradition

4. ENTRIES

4.1. A boat will be considered entered if it so in at least two of the regattas mentioned in paragraph 1. and she complies with the conditions of paragraph following 5.2.

5. SCORE

5.1. For the delivery of the Trophy, the following score system will be applied:

- a) The points scored by each boat in the final classification of her class, in each regatta that form the Trophy, will be divided by the number of participants in that Class in that regatta.
- b) For each boat, the points obtained in each regatta will be added.
- c) The winner in each Class will be that who makes less points.

5.2. A participant will be considered as such, according to the previous paragraph, if it starts at least in one race in at least two regattas of the four that form the Trophy.

5.3. A participating boat (according to the previous paragraph) that doesn't take part in one regatta will be considered, according to the score of the Trophy, as DNS in each one of the races of such regatta.

6. CLASSIFICATIONS

6.1. A classification will be established for each one of the participating classes.

6.2. The Real Asociación Nacional de Cruceros (RANC) will establish and authenticate the final classification.

7. TROPHY

7.1. The first classified in each participating Class will those who receive the Classics Mare Nostrum trophy.

7.2. The trophies will be delivered in the prize-giving ceremony celebrated in the last regatta of that year.

8. LANGUAGE

The Spanish text of this Notice will prevail.
